Sherman admitted to Morning Breeze following a hospital stay with a diagnosis of COPD exacerbation. Sherman presented with notable weakness in both upper and lower extremities and balance deficits in standing. He also needed assistance with activities of daily living. Sherman had been placed on a mechanical soft diet at admission.

He participated in three weeks of physical, occupational, and speech therapy for balance training, strengthening, gait training, and assessment of swallowing function.

Upon discharge, Sherman was able to ambulate throughout the facility with the use of a cane or rollator and complete activities of daily living. He was also able to return to a regular diet! Through his hard work, Sherman was able to return home and back to his prior level of function.
