Nancy was at home after having a spinal fusion when her condition worsened. She had bilateral sacral insufficiency fractures, which led to her admission to Morning Breeze. She received physical, speech, and occupational therapy to regain the ability to walk, improve independence with activities of daily living, and improve cognition. Upon admission, all of her mobility and self-care tasks required maximum assistance from others. She was unable to walk and was in a great deal of pain.

Nancy initially engaged in many therapy activities to reduce pain. Upon discharge, she only needed supervision for all mobility, including walking 300', and occasional assist with activities of daily living.

Nancy was able to return home with her husband, where she is looking forward to enjoying the weather in her front porch swing.
